Here's one example of a disposable UV shield that I am aware of, however there may be other solutions for blocking UV that are available. <http://www.youveeshield.com/> If premature aging is a concern, these shields lower UV exposure to virtually non-existent levels. They don't cover the nail bed itself, no worries there as the nail plate has a high natural SPF so the nail bed is naturally protected against any UV exposure from nail lamps. Also, the nail matrix is covered in a thick layer of skin, so overexposure to the matrix is very unlikely.
